

## Eligibility Criteria

An applicant passed **H.S. (10+2) level in (2017, 2018 and 2019) with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in the subject (or related subject) or vice versa**, is eligible to apply for Honours Courses.

## Calculation of Merit Point

Merit Point will be calculated by adding 10% of the aggregate with the marks obtained in the subject for which Hons. is sought. In case of the subjects having no subject bar, the marks obtained in the English language or the subject applied for (whichever is higher) will be added. For Merit Point calculation, aggregate will be calculated by adding the marks obtained in best four subjects **including English Subject**.
