Audit

The Govt. Audit for the year 2019-20 has been completed. The Internal Audit for the year 2020-21 & 2021-22 completed and the Govt. Audit for the same years will be done after allotment of Audit Firm by the DPI, West Bengal. Internal audit for the year 2022-23 is under progress. Performance Audit on Grantin-Aid in respect of Higher Education for the period from 2017-18 to 2021-22 has been done by the A.G. Audit team on & from 05/04/2023 to 06/04/2023.

Biodiversity Park

The Biodiversity Park has been set up inside the college campus with the administrative approval and financial sanction of Rupees Nine Lakh Eighty Thousand Four Hundred (Rs. 9,80,400.00) of the Dept. of Environment, Govt. of West Bengal last year. The park will function as an environmental education and conservation centre.

At present the initiative has the following components—

- 1. Restored eco-pond with indigenous fishes.
- 2. Wild habitat observation zone.
- 3. Conserved old Banyan tree.
- 4. Medicinal plant garden along with nursery.
- 5. Tropical Fruit orchard.
- 6. Interpretation Center supporting education and research work.

On 15th August 2023, the park has been inaugurated by Dr. H. S. Debnath, Honourable Chairman, West Bengal Bio-diversity Board.

Solar Tree

For the long-term use of green and clean energy, a solar tree has been installed within our college campus with the help of Durgapur CMERI (Central Mechanical Engineering Research Institute). The solar tree was inaugurated by the District Magistrate of Paschim Medinipur on 3rd of March 2022. This 11.55 kW peak power solar tree has a total of 35 solar PV panels, each with a power of 330 watts and can produce 35-45 units of green and clean energy on typical sunny day. The solar tree has already produced 16,293 units of electric power in our campus till 22nd of July 2023. It is producing average 42 units of power per day and 1250 units per month from the very beginning. This green and emission free solar power generation is equivalent to the reduction of 9287 kg of carbon dioxide emission to our environment.

Construction of new Main Entry Gate

The new main entry gate of the college had been constructed to commemorate the Autonomous status received from UGC. It was inaugurated on 7th December 2022 by Mr. Sukumar Roy, Managing Director, Amer-Sil Katex Pvt. Ltd., Kharagpur and Mr. Alain Cattiaus, Managing Director, Amer-Sil S.A. (Luxembourg).

Academic Activities

Since the last Foundation Day, our college has made significant progress in teaching, research, and extension activities. Currently 6 Major Research Projects are active in different departments of the College, while the reports of 11 Completed Research Projects have been submitted this year. Numbers of quality research papers have been written by the faculty members.

Banamahotsav

Banamahotsav has been successfully celebrated this year on 14/07/2023 with the assistance of the Alumni Association "Balaka", and the NSS of this college. 30 saplings have been planted inside the Biodiversity Park and more than 200 plants at various places of the campus. The programme was led by the principal of the college.

College Cooperative Credit Society Ltd.

The Staff Co-operative Credit Society of Raja N.L. Khan Women's College has been working effectively over years. The last Annual General Meeting of the Society was held on 31/03/2023. Total number of BOD Meeting held during this year is 13. At present, there are 110 (T.S. – 56, N.T.S. – 24, Hostel Staff – 06 and SACT – 24) members in the society. Total amount of loan given to the members in the financial year 2022-23 is Rs. 99,02,000.00 (Ninety-nine lac two thousand).

College Land

The lease deed of college land has been extended by ADM & DLRO, Paschim Medinipur for 30 years from 22/08/2017.

Hostels

The College has six hostels at present. Nearly 500 boarders reside in these six hostels. Massive renovation work of the Pravabati Bhavan and Lavatories, and electrical repairing works of all the buildings have been done. A big kitchen has been constructed for hostel boarders. One of the old kitchens has been transformed into the Hostel Common Room with all facilities.

Supply of Water in the Campus

The Supply of water in hostels, laboratories, and staff quarters is done by Public Health Engineering Department, Govt. of West Bengal. This department supervises the pumping of water from a big well, situated at Gope Nandini at 1.5 K.M. from the college, and water is stored in a huge overhead reservoir inside the college campus, from which water is delivered. Beside this, another deep tube-well was installed inside the campus. However, during the summer season, our college campus often faces scarcity of water. The College Authority is grateful to Mr. Subrata Mukherjee, MIC, PHE & Panchayet and Rural Development for

sanctioning of one deep tube-well and one Water ATM for this college. A water filter with capacity of 3000 lt. has been installed in the hostel last year with the assistance of the Dept. of Chemical Engineering, IIT, KGP, under the supervision of Prof. Sirsendu De. Two more water filters of 1500 lit. capacity mentioned above have been installed near Rabindra Neer and Controller Section this year.

College Annual Sports 2022 – 23

The Annual Athletic meet, 2022 was held on 3rd December 2022 at our college playground.
