



**Gender Wise Population Across Age Groups**




**Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections**





### Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section












Irrigated area and unirrigated area of total cultivable area

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
**Source Wise Irrigation Coverage among then households**









**Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops**





### Cattle wise population per household among various







### Lighting Source and usage in Village




